

Regulations

European Animated Shortfilm Competition

3d Eksjö Animation Festival 27-29 September 2007

1. Animated shortfilms produced in a european country, whith a running time of no more than 30 minutes are accepted for consideration. Eligible screening format is DVD. The festival needs a copy of the film on DVD-rom.
2. Entries most have been produced no earlier than two years prior to the deadline (i.e. after 29 June 2005).
3. Films with other than English dialogue/commentary must have English subtitles. The festival reserves the right to consider exeptions for films with Swedish dialogue/commentary.
4. There are no fees for participating in Eksjö Animation Festival. Participants are not entitled to claim fees for the screening of their films at the festival.
5. Films and other material will not be returned.
6. Entry must be made on the 2007 entry form supplied by the Eksjö Animation Festival. Entry of a film is binding and implies acceptance of the regulations.
7. The deadline for entry is June 29, 2007.
8. Decitions regarding the selection of films will be reached by the end of August and a full list of the selected films will be published on the website by September 3.
9. All selected films will be presented in the festival catalogue.
10. In the event of dicagrement concerning the interpretation of the regulations, the interpreta tion of the festival will take precedance.
11. All costs by sending a film to the festival is paid by the sender. Shipments from abroad must be marked "for cultural use only, no commercial value".
12. All participating films in the European Animated Shortfilm Competition compete for the following awards:
 - Eksjö Grand prix
 - Best animation
 - Best design
 - Audience award
 - The Jurys Special price
 - ANOBA nomination
13. The jury is appointed by the Eksjö Animation festival.
